Learn about new and proposed rules, policies, in-process, and upcoming regulations that could impact your non-stormwater National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. The NPDES requires a permit for all facilities discharging pollutants from a point source to a water of the state. Pollutants are broadly defined as any type of industrial, municipal, or agricultural wastewater. Examples of point sources are publicly owned treatment works, industrial facilities, and urban runoff.
